



## 2010 Art & Architecture Tour PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST

The 2010 Art & Architecture Tour (A&A Tour) is on Friday, May 14. It will feature local photographers' works of historic buildings or structures in Downtown North. Knox Heritage will solicit photographers' submissions with the help of local arts organizations and through various media outlets. Entries will be judged by a panel of professional artists, art educators, gallery owners, and others. Winning entries will be the basis and primary focus of the tour route, and will be framed and displayed in a gallery space starting the day of the tour. They will be available for the general public to view and/or purchase following the tour.

Knox Heritage, founded in 1974, advocates for the preservation of places and structures with cultural or historical significance. A part of Knox Heritage's activity centers on general education about our community's unique and significant architecture. We constantly seek new ways to integrate our message of the importance of historic preservation with interesting activities, engaging the public in an informative and enjoyable way. Knox Heritage's A&A Tour is one method of educating the public about Knoxville's historic architecture and its important place in the man-made landscape of the future.

### SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

#### Who is eligible

Amateur and professional photographers aged 16 & over who reside in Knox County or in one of the eight adjacent counties: Anderson, Blount, Grainger, Jefferson, Loudon, Roane, Sevier and Union.

#### Photography requirements

The contest is limited to photographs that were taken by the submitting photographer that have not been previously published nor widely reproduced/distributed. Photographs may be black & white or color. The main subject must be a historic building or structure at least 50 years old and still in existence (no old photos of buildings or structures that are now demolished). Subjects must be located in Downtown North, within the following boundaries: north of 5th Avenue; south of Woodland Avenue/Glenwood Avenue; west of Hall of Fame Drive; and east of the railroad tracks near Interstate 275. A map with these boundaries is attached. Subjects located on either side of these boundary lines are permitted.

#### Number of entries per photographer

Up to ten (10) entries per photographer may be submitted. Entries may be unique subjects or various photographs of one primary subject. All entries must be submitted within a single application. There is an additional fee for applications with more than four (4) entries (see Entry Fees).

#### Format of entries

Provide the following in one envelope marked with your name, daytime telephone number, and e-mail address:

- Completed application form with payment.
- Three (3) unframed and unmatted photographic prints of each entry, sized no smaller than 5" x 7" and no larger than 8.5" x 11". On the back of each print, write the corresponding letter of the entry as listed on the application form.
- One (1) high-resolution (minimum size 2400 x 3600 pixels or greater) digital copy of each entry, on a single CD-R or CD-RW disc. You may write your name on the CD sleeve or case.
- The 2010 tour booklets featuring winning photos will be a set of postcards. **Please keep in mind that photos will be printed in a standard postcard size. Winning photos that are unusually tall or wide may be presented in "letterbox" style in order to fit on the postcard.**

*The prints and digital images **must not** include the photographer's name.* Prints will be available for pickup by the applicant after June 1, 2010. Knox Heritage is not responsible for damage to submitted prints.

### Submission Deadline

**Applications with photos must be received by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, April 2, 2010.** Entries can be mailed to: A&A Tour Photo Contest, c/o Knox Heritage, P.O. Box 1242, Knoxville, TN 37901-1242, or delivered by hand to Knox Heritage, 1300 N. Broadway, Knoxville, TN 37917. *Late entries will not be accepted.*

### Entry Fees

**\$10.00** for 1 – 4 entries, or **\$20.00** for 5 – 10 entries. Payment is accepted in the form of cash, check or money order. Payment is required with the completed application. *Entries without payment will not be accepted.*

### Judging Criteria

Entries will be anonymous to the jury panel. The panel will select winners based on adherence to the stated requirements, suitability for inclusion on a tour, and overall artistic merit. No specific quantitative criteria (e.g., a points system) will be used; the selection of winners is at the discretion of the jury panel and is final. *Entries may be disqualified if the age of the building or structure cannot be verified as older than 50 years.*

### Winning Entries

A minimum of twelve (12) entries will be selected as winners, with no more than two (2) winning entries by any one photographer. Winners will be notified during the week of April 19, 2010. Winners will receive:

- Five (5) copies of the tour booklet, featuring all winning photographs and historical information.
- Free admission for one (1) person, and 50% off admission for one (1) person to the opening reception and tour.
- Special mention in the Knox Heritage Summer newsletter and on the KH website.

Winning entries will be matted and framed (up to 16" x 20") and displayed at Ironwood Studios on the day of the tour, and then at a gallery location for a few weeks following the tour. Photographers can choose whether to sell their images. Prices are set by the photographer, and proceeds after gallery commission will be given to the photographer. Unsold pieces will be available for pickup.

### Event Information

Once the winning entries have been chosen, Knox Heritage will establish a suitable tour route and research the subject(s) featured in each photograph. A tour booklet will be produced and given to each tour attendee. Knox Heritage will arrange for tour guides to escort groups along the route to provide detail about the historic building or structure featured in each photograph. The event will include a reception with the winning photographers for tour attendees. Biographical information about each winning photographer will be included in the gallery display and in the tour booklet.

### Photo Permissions

All entries remain the property of the photographers, but Knox Heritage retains the right to use any and all entries for archival, promotional and/or educational use without advance permission. Digital copies of all entries will be retained by Knox Heritage and all subsequent uses will include the photographer's credit. Knox Heritage may also request permission from each photographer to sell reproductions of the images.

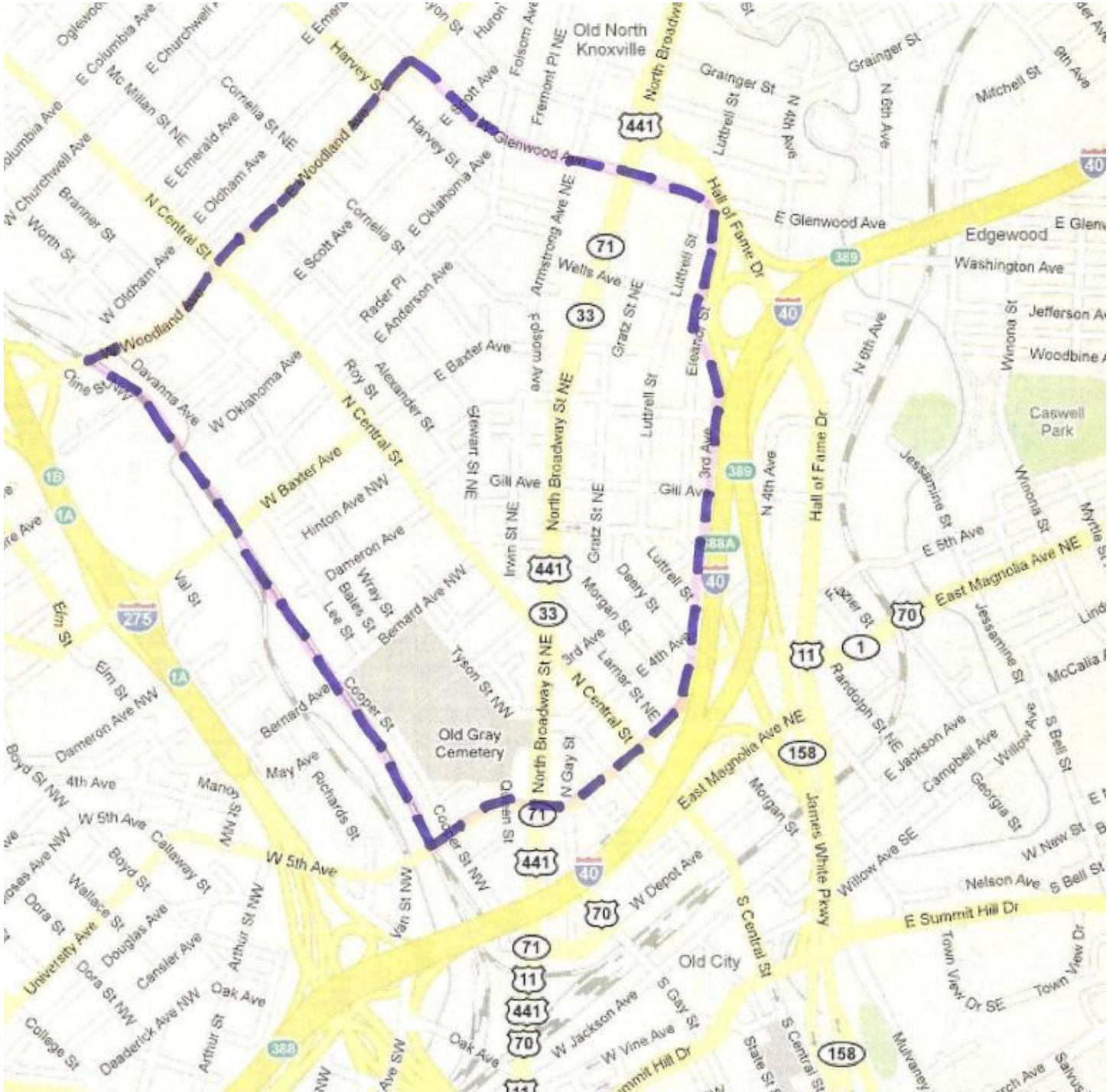
